2. JOB DESCRIPTION

Purpose

The role will guide and support allocated students at undergraduate and postgraduate level on a one to one basis during their academic research project, management report or dissertation.

Main Duties and Responsibilities

- 1. Responsible for advising, guiding and supporting allocated students on a one to one basis in the hours allocated per student.
