- Perform quarterly case reviews and prepare reports.
- Referral and monitoring of treatment and clinical investigations.
- Implementing and coordinating return to work plans.
- Financial management of cases.
- Support and guide other in-house multi-disciplinary team members by assisting with injury specific issues within your scope of practice.
- Review medical reports and provide independent rehabilitation strategy.
