Council met and:

Received John Cowman's end of year report reviewing the achievements of CSP in 2024 and priorities for 2025.

Set the 2025 CSP budget.

Decided that additional regulation of advanced practice physiotherapists would not add to patient safety so should not be supported.

Agreed a range of updates to membership rules, including recognition of the Welsh Level Three Diploma in Physiotherapy as a basis for admittance as an associate member. None of the other changes alter membership entitlements or eligibility.

Approved changes in principle to the Charter to recognise CSP's mutual trading status, subject to a further approval by Council and agreement in principle by Privy Council.

Approved strategic principles on AI which will guide CSP policy and which can assist members in considering the use of AI in practice, research, education or work settings.
